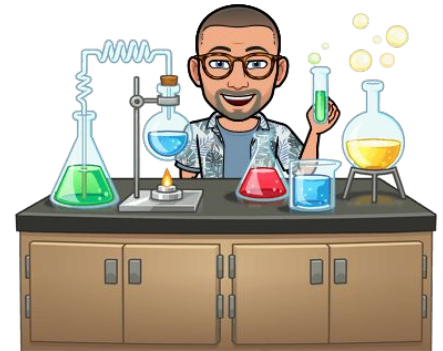
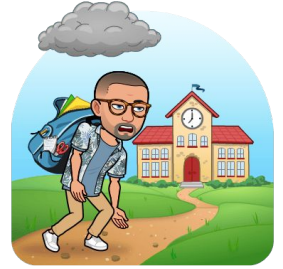

Updates to Quarantine Protocols 11-1-21



What Has NOT Changed



If a student tests positive for a case of COVID-19:

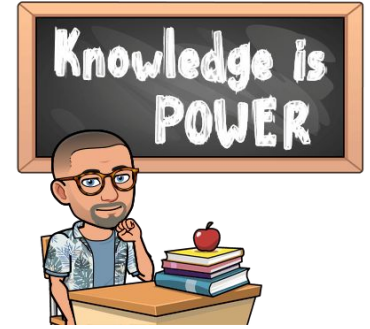
- Required to isolate for 10 days
- Return to school after 10 days if asymptomatic and there are no new cases of COVID-19 within the household

Always contact the School District Office to notify if there is a positive COVID-19 test result

Face Coverings, Physical Distancing, and Staying Home When Sick

The following changes apply to Close Contacts only

Close Contact Defined



A person who was exposed to a person with a confirmed case of COVID-19

- Within 6 feet of a confirmed case for 15 cumulative minutes in a 24 hour period during the infectious period:
 - 2 days before the onset of symptoms or 2 days before the positive test collection date
- K-12 indoor or outdoor classroom or other structured environment with assigned seating, the close contact definition excludes students who were at least 3 feet away from an infected student when both students were wearing face coverings and other preventive strategies were in place

Quarantining if a Student is a Close Contact of a Confirmed Case of Covid-19:

Option #1-Test to Stay-**This is only an option if the student was a close contact AT SCHOOL**

- Student is able to continue to come to school if they are symptom free, AND
- The parent/guardian agree to and sign off on the Test to Stay Program, AND
- The student tests negative on days 5 and 7 of a modified quarantine, AND
- The family and student agree to follow the modified quarantine (quarantine at home when not at school), AND
- The student does not develop symptoms during their modified quarantine, and/or there are no new cases of COVID-19 within the household



Quarantining if a Student is a Close Contact of a Confirmed Case of Covid-19:

Option #2-7 Day Quarantine

- Student quarantines at home for 7 days from the date of last close contact (exposure)-quarantine ends after day 7 IF:
- Student tests for COVID-19 no sooner than on or after day 5 post exposure and is negative, AND:
- Proof of a negative result is provided including:
 - First and last name the individual tested
 - The type of test performed (molecular or antigen)
 - The date the specimen was collected-must be on or after day 5 post-exposure, AND:
- The student does not develop symptoms during their 7 day quarantine after a negative test result and continues to monitor symptoms until day 14



Quarantining if a Student is a Close Contact of a Confirmed Case of Covid-19:



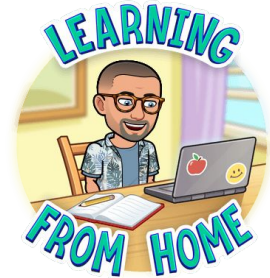
Option #3-10 Day Quarantine

- No COVID-19 Testing is conducted
- Student quarantines at home for 10 days from the date of last close contact (exposure)-quarantine ends after day 10 IF:
- The student does not develop symptoms during their 10 day quarantine (continue monitoring symptoms until day 14)
- If symptoms develop during 10 day quarantine, students must remain in quarantine and should be tested

Quarantining if a Student is a Close Contact of a Confirmed Case of Covid-19:

Option #4-14 Day Quarantine-may be recommended by LHJ based on situation

- No COVID-19 Testing is conducted
- Student quarantines at home for 14 days from the date of last close contact (exposure)-quarantine ends after day 14 IF:
- The student does not develop symptoms during their 14 day quarantine
- If symptoms develop during 14 day quarantine, students must remain in quarantine and should be tested



Those Exempt from Quarantine as a Close Contact

Those who are fully vaccinated and do not have symptoms

- Testing is recommended after day 5 from exposure
- Isolate and get tested if symptoms occur



Those individuals who had confirmed COVID-19 in the past 3 months, have recovered, and do not have symptoms

- Antigen testing recommended 5-7 days post exposure
- Monitor symptoms and get evaluated by a healthcare provider if symptoms occur
